**Membership** Junior membership of the club also provides that the parent(s) / carer(s) / guardian(s) of the child are given non-voting membership of the club as part of that junior membership. This entitles the parent(s) / carer(s) / guardian (s) no additional privileges that would otherwise be gained by paying the appropriate adult membership fee(s). Any use of facilities (for example social / training / playing) may incur such charges as applicable to relevant adult membership.

Membership to the club costs £ 25 per season (Winter, Spring, early Summer, late Summer). In addition members are expected to pay £ 3 for each match they attend. The fee is used to help pay for coaching costs, equipment and area hire.

**Medical consent** I give my consent that in an emergency situation, the Club may act in loco parentis, if the need arises for the administration of emergency first aid and / or other medical treatment which in the opinion of a qualified medical practitioner may be necessary. I also understand that in such an occurrence that all reasonable steps will be taken to contact me or the alternative adult whom I have named in section B of this form. **Data Protection** The Club will use the information provided on this Membership Form (together with other information it obtains about the player) to administer his/her cricketing activity at the Club and in any activities in which he/she participates through the Club and to care for and supervise activities in which he/she is involved.

In some cases this may require the Club to disclose the information to County Boards, Leagues and to the England and Wales Cricket Board. In the event of a medical issue or child protection issue arising, the Club may disclose certain information to doctors or other medical specialists and/or to police, children's social care, the Courts and/or probation officers and, potentially to legal and other advisers involved in an investigation.

## Code of conduct

As a member of Newham Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following junior code of conduct:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late. If players are consistently late to training and or matches without a valid excuse it will affect their selection for matches. If players are late by 10 minutes or more, without a valid excuse, they will be omitted from activities.
- Members must wear suitable kit - cricket whites - for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events by the agreed date between player and coach. If the agreed date has passed and the fees have not been paid the player runs the risk of being omitted from any cricket activities Newham Cricket Club offer. The coaches' decision is final.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Players must take responsibility for club equipment and facilities. This includes taking and putting away club kit and treating home and away facilities with care and responsibility.
